
What Should I Do After a Car Accident? Dos and Don'ts

SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION if you or a passenger is injured in the accident or think you may have <u>hidden injuries</u>.



DON'T ADMIT FAULT just tell the police officer what happened to prevent an accident liability dispute.



CALL 911 to create a <u>police report</u> & prevent blame being placed on you.



DON'T RECORD A STATEMENT with any insurance company. Just say "no".



EXCHANGE INFO including drivers license, vehicle VIN & insurance.



DON'T SIGN ANYTHING at all from an insurer. Avoid this common <u>mistake</u>.



TAKE PICS of damage to <u>both</u> cars, their license plate, & accident location.



DON'T SETTLE OR NEGOTIATE on your own without an injury attorney.



DOCUMENT DETAILS about the location of the accident with a diagram, if possible, and weather info.



DON'T POST ON SOCIAL MEDIA anything about your accident, as the insurance company may use it to <u>deny your claim</u>.



CALL A <u>PERSONAL INJURY LAWYER</u> for a <u>free consult</u> regarding your injury accident claim and find out <u>why you</u> <u>should hire a personal injury lawyer</u>.



DON'T WAIT to contact a car wreck lawyer, as evidence - such as videos from nearby businesses - disappear quickly, and they can help guide you.
